## District Championships 2026 Terms of Competition

- The Rules of Golf and the local rules of the Host Club shall be the rules of play during the Championships
- All District Championship events are open to players whose home club is affiliated with D&SWDLGA Inc.
- Nett and Daily events are open to all players.
- Players must have a GA Handicap and provide evidence of this on request.
- GA Handicap limits are : Silver - up to 16.9 Bronze I 17.0 to 27.5 Bronze II 27.6 to 45.0
- A player's current handicap at the beginning of the 1st round will apply to the 36 hole championships.
- Practice on the course is not allowed between rounds (Rule 5.2b)
- Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the D&SWDLGA Match Committee
- If the entrant is under 18 years of age, this nomination form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- Competitors are requested to **register** at the Clubhouse **30 minutes before tee off**.
- Dress regulations of the Host Club must be adhered to
- Motorised transport is permitted in all events
- Measuring devices are permitted in all events
- Mobile phones are permitted however an audible emission during play is a serious breach of etiquette and will attract a warning.
- A competitor must not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance her performance. A competitor infringing this condition may be disqualified.
- A tie in Championship 36 hole Gross Events will be decided by a playoff on holes and at a time to be decided by the Match Committee. If a player leaves the course, she will forfeit the playoff.
- Ties in other events will be decided by the count back system.
- Any disputes must be submitted to the Match Committee in writing within 15 minutes of the close of play each day.
- It is a condition of entry that players assent to references to them, and pictures of them being published via any medium including the internet. However, if a player has personal, safety or domestic circumstances that require them not to be identified, please notify the Match Committee in writing prior to the event.
- D&SWDLGA accepts no liability or responsibility for loss, theft or damage to participants equipment.
- All hire carts will be hired on a seat by seat arrangement. Carts will be allocated according to need.
- Players who bring their own carts may arrange a person to share their cart.
- If a player brings their own cart and is willing to share with any other player, the cost will be equivalent to that set by the Host Club.
- The Match Committee may adjust the program or conditions as needed. It may also change handicap limits if entries exceed capacity, or cancel an event if there are not enough entries.
