Dear Members,

Following our recent review, the committee has simplified the qualifying conditions for the Queensland District Championships. Please see the updated details below.

- A player's grade will be determined by their GA as of 15th October 2026.
- Players must compete in either the 2026 Matchplay Championships or the 2026 District Championships to be eligible.
- All qualifying events are listed on the accompanying Nomination form.

Scoring criteria:

- Division 1 Best 3 gross scores to count.
- Division 2 & 3 Best 3 nett scores to count.
- These scores will be averaged and the players with the best 2 averages will qualify.
- In the event of a tie the player with the next best score in that division will be selected.
- In the event that a selected player cannot play, the player with the next best average will replace them.

For example: Player A average 76 nett; Player B average 78 nett; Player C average 78 nett. Player A is selected, Player B's next best score is 80 nett, Player C's is 82 nett. Player B will be selected and Player C will be the first reserve for the Division.

Zone representation:

- A position will be reserved for a player from Zones 2, 4, and 5 with the best average
- If no player nominates from these zones, the position will be allocated to the next eligible player.

Nominations have now reopened. Please note that scores will only be counted once a nomination has been received.

Thank you to those who have already sent in a nomination form. If you have already submitted your nomination, no further action is required.

A leaderboard will be made available to all participants on a regular basis.
