Players must be able to attend a minimum of 3 of 5 trial dates (as listed below) where they will play 18 holes of Matchplay and earn points. The best 3 of the 5 trial dates attended will be used towards determining a player’s score. Obviously, the more times a player attends these trials the better her chances of having a high score. Points will be allocated as follows: Holes won = 1 point. Holes squared = ½ point. **These points will ONLY be used to assist the selectors.** However, they will not necessarily determine a player’s selection. The selected team will consist of 8 players (6 plus 2 reserves) who will need to be available for team bonding and training sessions to be organised by the team Manager (Aliecia Freeman) & Captain (Margaret Richards). Following this training period, the number will be reduced to the final squad of 6. However, in the event of illness or accident to a team member/members prior to the Meg Nunn event then one/or more of the reserves will be notified of their inclusion to the team. This year the event will be held at McLeod Golf Club (Brisbane) & we will be arranging for an extra trial to be held in conjunction with a McLeod competition. ***The cost of the trial games at City Golf Club will be \$10 per player per round & payable at the Pro Shop prior to play.***

The following dates have been set aside for Meg Nunn trials and you will be contacted to confirm which dates you are able to attend. Players over 65 years or with a Medical Certificate may use a cart.

Eligibility – Please ensure you meet ALL these requirements:

1. Handicap range – GA 16.2 and under.
2. A player’s eligibility to compete for a district is determined by the district where the player is handicapped.
3. State players and QAS students are ineligible for selection until two years have elapsed from that experience.
4. Age is limited to 18 years & over.
5. Players must be Australian citizens or have lodged citizenship application papers.
